Species for which Release Sites are Needed: <u>Primarily</u> Squirrel, Waterfowl (ducks/geese), Cottontail rabbit, **Opossum.** We are also seeing sites for Songbird, and some Raptors (hawks/owls).

Suitable: Properties located in rural areas, away from busy roads, no feral cats on the property, domestic cats not allowed outside, no hunting or trapping allowed. Access to water (pond/creek) is desirable. Ability to drive a van on the property to transport animals to release location. 5 acre minimum.

Not Suitable: Properties in cities or towns, adjacent to busy roads, where feral cats are present or domestic cats are allowed outside, or which allow hunting or trapping, or are located next to public hunting grounds or private property where hunting is allowed.

<u>Squirrel species</u> require good tree cover, including nut-producing trees (hickory, walnut, oak), with similar habitat located adjacent to the property to allow room for dispersal, where there are some but not an overabundance of squirrels, and where there are no resident raptors (hawks/owls). Squirrels are released in nest boxes which must be attached to trees with a tree. We need driving access to the release spot.

<u>Cottontail rabbit & Opossum</u> require good tree cover, and ground cover, including dead tree snags and brush piles, no dogs running on the property.

 $\underline{\text{Waterfowl}}$ require ponds minimum $\frac{1}{2}$ acre with natural vegetation in and around the pond, including trees. We need to be able to drive up near the pond for release.

<u>Raptors</u> require an area that is not already occupied by that species.
